Flying Field Directions: The flying site is located in the City of Aurora CO on Quincy Avenue approximately 1.5 miles East of Aurora Reservoir Recreational facility. From I-225 take Parker Road Exit, go south to Quincy Avenue, go East 4 miles past the E-470 underpass and Gun Club Road for another 3.5 miles. The field is located on left hand side of the road. E-470 is open and may represent a quicker or easier route to the Mile Hi RC Flying Field. Exit Quincy and proceed east
