Flying Field Directions: The flying site is located in the City of Aurora, CO on Quincy Avenue approximately 1.5 miles east of Aurora Reservoir Recreational Facility. **1.)** From I-225, take Parker Road Exit; go south to Quincy Avenue; go east 4 miles under the E-470 overpass and Gun Club Road for another 3.5 miles. The field is located on the left. **2.)** E-470 to Quincy Exit and proceed east approximately 3.5 miles.
